VIDEO CAMERA MOUNT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

This camera mount has been designed to mount a small, lightweight video camera to any Brey-Krause harness guide bar. Before installing the mount to the harness guide bar, attach your camera to the mount and check for a proper fit.

Step 1.

Mount camera using tee bolt- (A) supplied. Carefully screw tee bolt- (A) into the camera-mounting lug. Make sure the thread engagement is sufficient. If not remove tee bolt- (A), retaining clip-(C) and then remove (1) spacer- (D) under the head of tee bolt- (A). Reinstall the retaining clip.

Step 2.

Install retaining strap supplied. Cut to length if necessary.


Step 3.

Attach the camera mount to bar via clamp block- (E). Snug clamp bolts at this time.

Step 4.

Aim camera. Adjust height, pan, and tilt via L-handles- (F).

Notes:

- 1.) Most video cameras have a provision for screw- (B), which is used to keep the camera from rotating. It can be removed if necessary.
- 2.) Pull out L-handle- (F) and rotate to index.
