QUICK RELEASE FIRE EXTINGUISHER BRACKET INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

This fire extinguisher bracket is designed to hold a 2 1/2 pound AMEREX model 417 fire extinguisher.

Our bracket is used to mount a fire extinguisher to any of our mounting brackets or to any suitable surface. The hole pattern on our bracket matches the hole pattern on the bracket supplied with *AMEREX* extinguishers.

Step 1.

Determine the approximate mounting position of the fire extinguisher and the position of the mount release handle.

Step 2.

Loosen the band clamp bolts and slide the extinguisher bottle into the bracket. Just snug the band clamp bolts for now.

Step 3.

Squeeze the handle and release the base plate. Note which side is the handle side. Fasten the base to the mounting surface with 4 screws.

Step 4.

Snap the extinguisher and upper bracket onto the base. Make any final adjustments to the position of the bottle and tighten the band clamps.

To Use: Simply squeeze the handle to release the extinguisher from the base. Follow the extinguisher use instructions.

Note: When placing the extinguisher back on the base; be sure that the latch is fully engaged.
